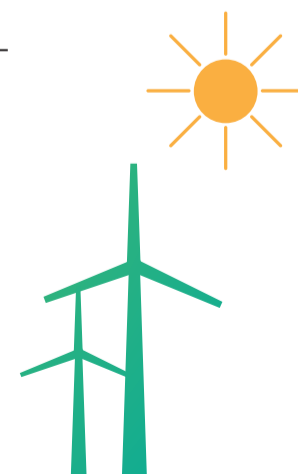

Entries may be submitted via email to **slaya2019@gmail.com** or delivered to 93 Brown Street, Armidale. (please advise via this email so that delivery can be arranged.)

If the entry involves a performance or presentation or similar, or off-site installation, an online submission explaining what, where and how is to be submitted by the closing time, and arrangements will be made to view the entry as appropriate.

Entries are open to anyone living (including school boarders) within the Armidale Regional Council area, minimum age 12 and maximum age 30, at last birthday prior to 31/01/2020. Group entries are allowed provided they fit into only one of the two nominated age groups. Entrants under 18 years of age must have the written permission of their parent / legal guardian for consent to the minor entering this competition

Winners will be announced at a venue & time TBA in February/March. Each prize winner will receive a certificate and payment.

To enter, the entry form must be completed and submitted online by the closing date and time nominated above. If applicable, any physical entry must also be delivered to the address nominated above by the closing date and time nominated above. If applicable, arrangement with SLA must be made by the closing date to arrange a visit to view any off-site installation or presentation or similar.
